ANAPHYLACTIC/ CARDIAC/ HYPOVOLEMIC SHOCK

The following injections

- Hvdrocortisone sodium succunate 100mg
- Adrenaline 1: 1000 (Epinephrine 1: 1000)
- Promethazine ampules
- Dextrose 50%
- Half strength Darrows and glucose solution
- Compound solution of sodium lactate
- Sodium chloride 0.9%
